


16 European regions from 12 different European countries, plus 1 UK national body aiming at the definition of a replicable systemic approach towards a transition to Circular Economy in EU regions



Bottom-Up approach of the SCREEN regions

- Proposal of a synergic use of regional funds (ESIF plus H2020) in a single application (Common Pot)
- Main idea (for future application) and Pilot action for immediate test
- Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for a <u>pilot application</u> (common pot) under the current programming period, through the use of ESIF article 70
- Its results will pave the way to a harmonized regulation in the next programming period
