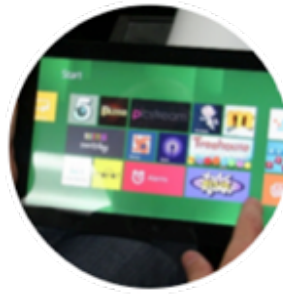
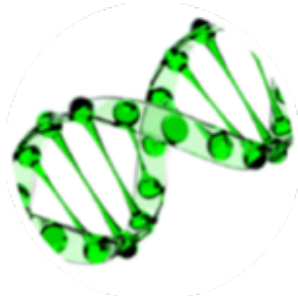
Support UK based businesses in engaging with Europe and H2020
