



#### **SCREEN - Synergic Circular Economy across European Regions**

### 4th SCREEN INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP: "Pamplona, 4th and 5th of September 2018

SCREEN is an H2020 coordinating and supporting action participated by 17 European regions, aiming at the definition of a replicable systemic approach towards a transition to Circular Economy in EU regions within the context of the Smart Specialisation Strategy. The project also deals with the identification and implementation of operational synergies between investments in research and innovation under Horizon 2020, the Structural Funds and the European Investment Funds.



Besides developing a common agreed approach to support a transition to a circular economy and to enhance existing smart specialization strategies of the involved regions, the project intends to develop some policy support advisory services to enable regions to invest EU funds in transnational value chains. Furthermore, the identification and implementation of operational synergies between investments in research and innovation under Horizon 2020, the Structural Funds and the European Investment Funds is also an important task of the project, addressed within the SCREEN Policy Lab.

#### **Workshop Objectives**

During the third workshop, the participants will discuss the results of Working Package 5 of the project: operational actions to connect the activities of the identified sectors of the involved regions in view of trans-national cooperation along the strategic value chains identified in the previous WPs. The goal of the workshop is to reach a common agreement about the procedure and the way of its presentation as a "Portfolio of tools" included in a Policy Makers recommendation Manual (Milestone 3).


